



Things got better in high school as I learned to wear my social butterfly hat when needed. I was selected as class president, selected to be on home coming court, selected at captain of the volleyball team for two years, and as prom committee president. My college applications looked great, but, I learned that genuine friendships are unicorns. While I had many "friends," I really only had two persons that I would identify as genuine friends in high school. I was enrolled in gymnastics, ballet, tap, and karate growing up.
