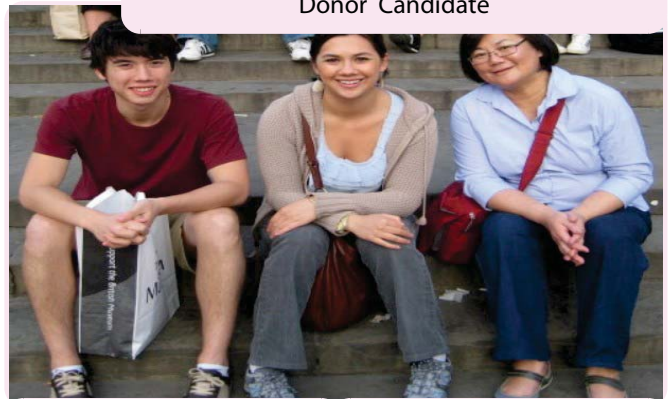

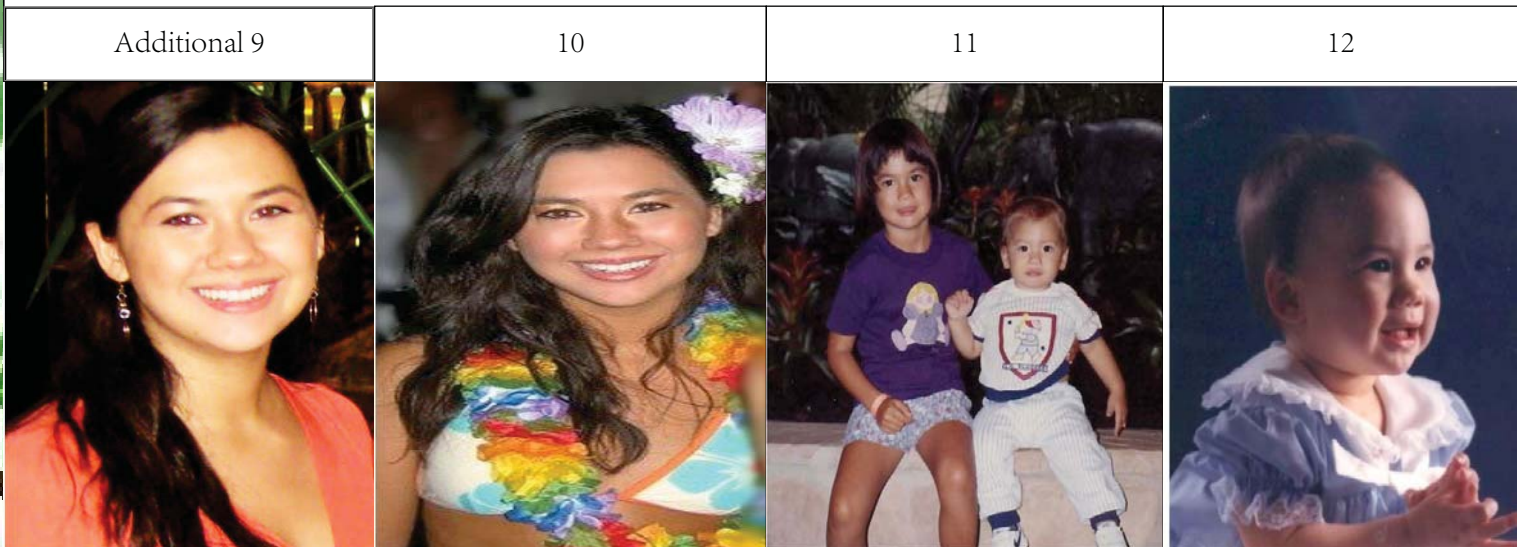
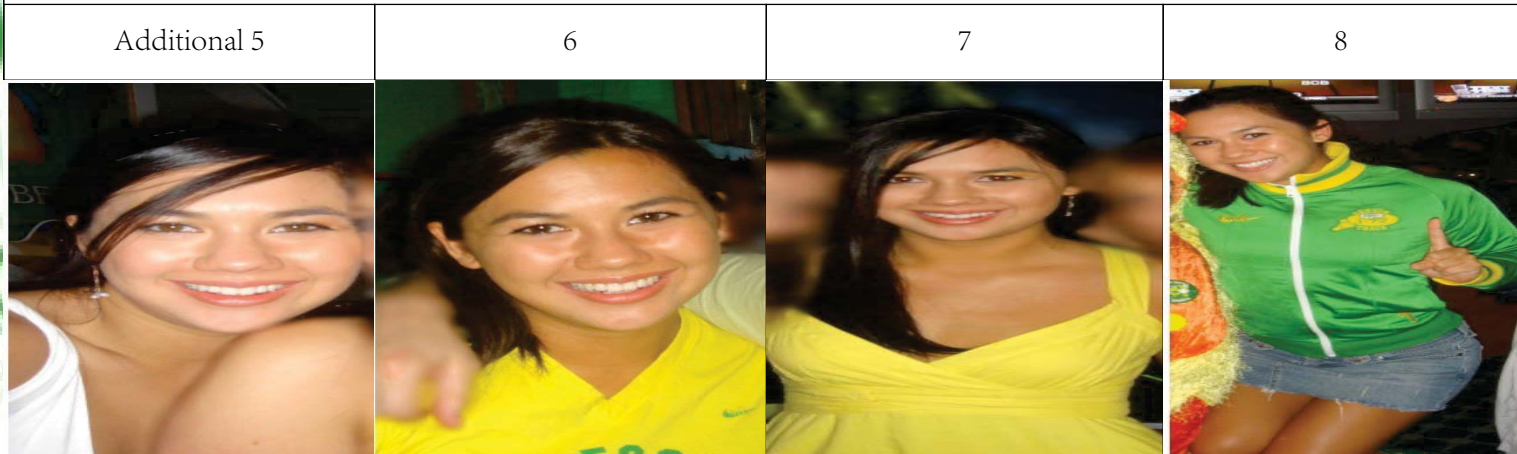

Mangos are an integral ingredient in Hawaiian cuisine, so the demand for mangos skyrocketed. My mom and dad told my brother and me that we could keep any money that we made from selling mangos, so we quickly settled our sibling differences and devised a plan to maximize our earning potential. That entire summer, we made a game of collecting the mangos as they fell. If one of us heard a Mango fall, we would shout "mango" and the last person to shout it would have to go outside to pick it up. It was very silly, but lots of fun. With the mangos we collected, we set up a roadside stand, which was a huge success (who could resist two cute kids selling mangos?).
